## RESEARCH IN PROGRESS THE GRAVES FAMILY OF IPSWICH

The following are excerpts from "Samuel Graves of Ipswich" originally researched and printed for The Essex Genealogist under "Research in Progress" Three Graves Families in the Volume 20, Number 4 issue by Marcia Wilson Wiswall Lindberg. Marcia was a librarian at the Lynnfield Public Library for many years. She also wrote many genealogical books on New England ancestry and was editor of The Essex Genealogist for 20 years. She is now retired.

Page 226 Volume 20, Number 4:

**SAMUEL(1) GRAVES** was born probably in England about 1622. He gave his age as 38 in a court testimony of 1660. Samuel died at Ipswich 22 November 1679 (E.O. Jamison, *The Choates of America (1986)*, date not found elsewhere. Samuel married about 1656, probably in Boston, GRACE BEAMSLEY, who was born at Boston, the 10<sup>th</sup> day of the 7<sup>th</sup> month 1635, daughter of William and Anne Beamsley (Boston Vital Records). It is probable that Grace was Samuel Graves' second wife. He referred to her as "my now wife" in several deeds. Grace Graves died at Ipswich 26 November 1730 in her 99<sup>th</sup> year (Ipswich Vital Records). Samuel was a hat weaver and felt maker by occupation.

**SAMUEL (2)GRAVES, JR** was born at Ipswich 5 August 1658 and died there 4 October 1732, age 74y 2m (Ipswich Vital Records). He married, first, at Ipswich, JOANNA PEARCE b. at Ipswich, 13 Oct 1659, daughter of Robert and Abigail (Symonds) Pearce. Samuel married secondly ELIZABETH -----, who survived him. Her last name has not been determined. Like his father, Samuel Graves, Jr. was a felt maker, or hatter, by occupation.

5. JOHN(3)GRAVES (Samuel(2)(1) was born at Ipswich about 1678 and died there 4 October 1775. He married at Ipswich, 30 December 1730 HANNAH PERKINS, who was born in 1707 (figured from her age at death) She died at Ipswich, 12 May 1791, age 84 (Ipswich VR)

He was a cabinet maker by occupation (J.C. Graves Mss) Children: 1. John, b. 11 Sept 1766, m. (1) 1 Sept 1791 Elizabeth Sayward, who d. 18 March 1800, m. (2) 4 July 1819, ABIGAIL W. HODGKINS (3 children by 2<sup>nd</sup> wife). 2. Moses, bpt 7 May 1769, d. 1794 in the West Indies; m. 7 Nov 1793, Deborah Safford (one child, Moses Graves) (K.V. Graves, 51, 82)

The following provides additional material regarding the family of JOHN GRAVES(3) (see John excerpt numbered iv. on the previous page) including offering further information pertaining to the wives of the four successive John Graves: John (3) and Hannah Perkins, John (4) and Elizabeth Pushee, John (5) and Elizabeth Sayward and John (6) and Abigail W. Hodgkins.

**JOHN GRAVES(3)**(Samuel(2)(1) was born at Ipswich about 1678 and died there 4 October 1775. He married at Ipswich, 30 December 1730.<sup>1</sup>

He married HANNAH PERKINS who was born 22 : 2m : 1707.<sup>2</sup> She died at Ipswich 12 May 1791, age 84.<sup>3</sup> Hannah was the daughter of Capt. Beamsley Perkins and Mrs. Hannah (Emerson) Glazier.<sup>4</sup>

Children of John Graves and Hannah Perkins, b. at Ipswich:

- i. John, bpt and died 27 July 1735
- ii. Beamsley, bpt 6 Feb 1736, d. 27 Feb 1736
- iii. Hannah, bpt 29 Apr 1739, d. 23 May 1739
- iv. John(4), bpt 8 January 1741, Ipswich, MA

**JOHN GRAVES (4)**(JOHN(3)Samuel(2)(1) was born at Ipswich about 1740 and baptized 8 Jan 1741,<sup>5</sup> Ipswich, MA. He married<sup>6</sup> Mrs. Elizabeth Pushee Johnson, widow, (int) 12 October 1765. John died at Ipswich on 7 March 1804<sup>7</sup>.

Mrs. Elizabeth Pushee Johnson, bpt 22 April 1739,<sup>8</sup> was the daughter of Gabriel Pushee/Pushey/Pouchi and Sarah Williams.<sup>9</sup> Elizabeth married (1) Joshua Johnson of Stow, MA, on 8 Dec 1763.<sup>10</sup> Joshua died (unknown). Elizabeth married (2) John Graves(4).

Gabriel Pushee/Pushey/Pouchi was one of the "first permanent settlers" of Winchendon, MA (the original grant was known as Ipswich Canada). <sup>11</sup> Nathan Pushee, Jr., who served as one of George Washington's Life Guards, was Gabriel's grandson and Elizabeth's nephew. <sup>12</sup>

i. **John(5)**, b. 11 Sept, 1766, Ipswich, MA

ii. Moses, bpt 7 May 1769, d. 1794 in the West Indies, m. 1793, Deborah Stafford (one child Moses Graves).<sup>13</sup>

iii. Elizabeth<sup>14</sup>, bpt 6 September 1772, m. Capt. John Sweet, Jr, <sup>15</sup>(b. 30 May 1772<sup>16</sup>, d at sea, 9 Jul 1821<sup>17</sup>). They had no children. Elizabeth died 14 Sept 1812.<sup>18</sup>

**JOHN GRAVES (5)**(JOHN(4)(3)Samuel(2)(1) was born 11 Sept 1766,<sup>19</sup> at Ipswich, MA. He married on 1 Sept 1791,<sup>20</sup> Elizabeth Sayward (bpt 08 Nov 1767<sup>2122</sup> - d. 18 March 1800<sup>23</sup>). John died 6 Sept 1820,<sup>24</sup> at Ipswich, MA. He was 55 years of age. John (5) was referred to as junior in the Ipswich marriage records since his father, John (4), was still alive.

Elizabeth Sayward was the daughter of John Sayward/Soward and Elizabeth Leatherland, married (int) 13 Oct 1764<sup>25</sup> in Ipswich, MA. Elizabeth Sayward Graves died on childbed at the age of 33. <sup>23</sup>

Children of John Graves and Elizabeth Sayward, b. at Ipswich:

- i. John(6), b. about 1793, d. 4 Mar 1870, Peabody, MA
- ii. Unknown, d. between 2 June/22 Jul 1799, age 5<sup>26</sup>
- iii. Unknown, b. 1800, d. 8 Mar 1800 at birth<sup>22</sup>

**JOHN GRAVES (6)**(JOHN(5)(4)(3)Samuel(2)(1) was born about 1793 (according to the age that he reported to U.S. Census and was recorded at his death) in Ipswich, MA. He died 4 March 1870<sup>27</sup>, at Peabody, MA.

John(6) married, 4 Jul 1819, Abigail Wise Hodgkins<sup>28</sup> (b. 18 Sept 1803, Marblehead, MA<sup>29</sup> - d. 14 Jan 1879, Peabody, MA<sup>30</sup>). Abigail was the daughter of Joseph Hodgkins and Abigail Swasey (m. 7 Nov 1793). <sup>31323334</sup>

SUSAN CHARLOTTE GRAVES(7) was born at Ipswich on 9 January 1835<sup>43</sup> and died 11 Dec 1915.<sup>44</sup>

She married Joseph D. Gardner<sup>43</sup> born 4 March 1836 to Benjamin Brown Gardner<sup>45</sup> and Lucy Foster Wilson. Joseph died, at Salem, 10 Feb 1913<sup>46</sup>. Joseph worked as a tanner and as a foreman for the tanneries. Susan and Joseph had five children, including **Waldo Dennett(8)**, b. 1 Oct 1874, Salem, MA,<sup>474849</sup> m. 10 Jun1902,<sup>50</sup> Charlotte Johnson, b. 1880, Prince Edward Island, died 12 Apr 1923.<sup>51</sup> Waldo D. worked as banker at Naumkeag Trust Company. Waldo D. died 31 Jul 1945<sup>52</sup>.

**Note:** Waldo(8) D. Gardner is the grandparent of Ann L. Gardner Switlik, co-founder of the Thomas Gardner Society (TGS). He is also a first cousin of Frank A. Gardner, MD, author of Thomas Gardner, Planter (Cape Ann, Salem) and some of his descendants (1907). The research for this update was done under the auspices of the TGS by John M. Switlik.
